**Code of Ethics for Adults working with Children and Youth:** The relationship between young people and their leaders is based on natural respect. As an adult in a leadership role, I will provide for the nurture, care and support of the children and youth. I will refrain from engaging in behavior that is harmful to their physical, emotional or spiritual development. I affirm that there is nothing in my background that would call into question my being entrusted with the supervision, guidance and care of children and youth.

I affirm that I have never been convicted of a crime or offense involving unlawful conduct, assault, or endangering the welfare of a child, nor has it been determined by a court or child welfare agency that I have abused a child. I understand that to protect the children and youth, myself and this congregation, that there must be a minimum of two adults in each classroom. Should I be disallowed to work with children or youth, I realize that I shall have no recourse against the ministerial staff.
