Delegates will:

Before General Assembly:

- Together with other delegates and with help from the Denominational Affairs team, research UUA business agenda items and policy proposals as necessary
- Plan to attend the listening session to be held at ERUUF (with hybrid options available) on **June 3 at 7:30 PM**. At this session, members of the congregation will have an opportunity to share feedback about items on the General Assembly business agenda; listen to and sincerely weigh the sentiments expressed therein
- Attend the planning meeting to be held online on **June 10 at 7:30 PM**.

During General Assembly:

- Attend the plenary sessions where business items are discussed and/or voted on
- Attend any sessions designated during the ERUUF planning meeting

After General Assembly

- Coordinate follow up and reporting with the Denominational Affairs Team
- Coordinate with other delegates to provide an oral report on the key developments at General Assembly to the Congregation in September
- Prepare a list of specific follow up items for ERUUF and any suggestions you may have. For example: Study Action Items, resolutions, or information relevant for specific committees.
